#### Summary of Confirmed Minutes of the 196th Meeting of the URA Board

1. The Board of the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) held its 196<sup>th</sup> meeting on 22 February 2024 (Thursday) at URA's Head Office. The meeting was chaired by Mr Chow Chung-kong and attended by 3 executive directors, 17 non-executive directors and a number of representatives from the Management. The Permanent Secretary for Development (Planning and Lands) (PSPL) joined part of the meeting to exchange views with Board Members on the proposed establishment of a dedicated office to provide support services to minority owners affected by compulsory sale. The agenda items discussed and major decisions reached are highlighted below.

#### <u>Dedicated Office to Provide Support Services to Minority Owners Affected</u> by Compulsory Sale (DOSS)

2. <u>PSPL</u> briefed <u>Members</u> on the proposed establishment of the DOSS in the Development Bureau after the enactment of the Land (Compulsory Sale for Redevelopment) (Amendment) Bill 2023, and the proposed establishment of an agent of DOSS in URA.
